North Wales

A visit to the North Wales region has much to offer to the traveller who enjoys the great outdoors and a place to relax and soak up some fresh air.

Mountains set within some splendid beautiful countryside. Whether



you seasoned walker or for just a quite stroll you'll find a walk to suit your particular requirements, see our signposted triangles around and up the mountain for various routes.

The river side (green trail) for instance takes in the flowing waters of the river Seem and follows the downward flow the glorious waterfall and alpine planted gardens.

Just a short 30 minute bus ride for Llanberis are the ancient ruins of Llansteffan Castle, completed in the late 12th Century this is a fine example of craftsmanship featuring a moat and draw bridge in keeping with how it would have looked back then.
